January 2019

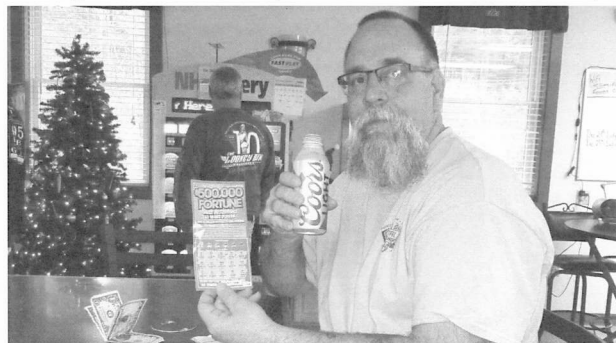

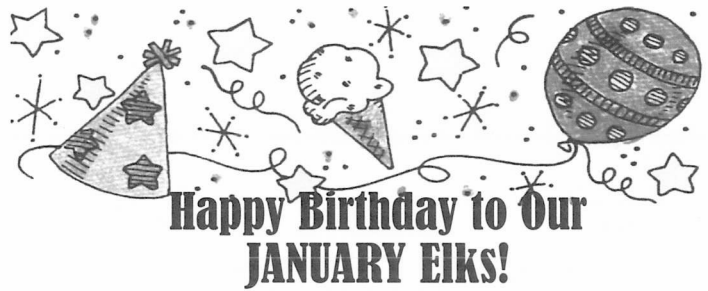

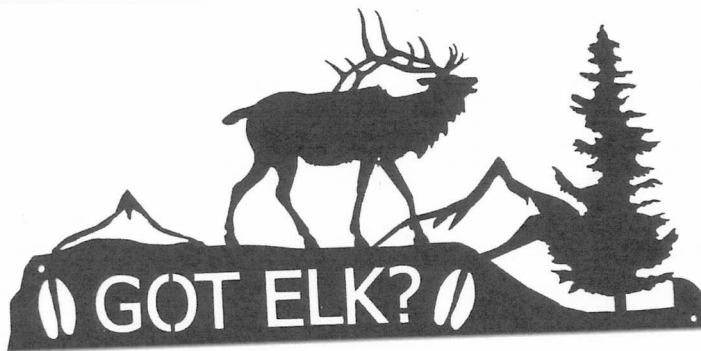
