

a Little History on THE ELKS COLORS

The Elk colors are Royal Purple and white, a combination deriving its origin from the history of the Clergy, Nobility and the People. Throughout Europe, the Orient and in Rome, the symbolism of colors was associated with severity of laws and customs. Each color in each pattern was identified religious, or political, and to change or alter it was a crime of rebellion. a desertion of principles, party, or cause. White denotes purity and absolute truth. When combined with Royal Purple, it signifies the love of truth and the highest degree of virtue. Purple is the badge of Kingship, the color for the robes of Emperors and High Priests, and signifies highest favor.


