New Hampshire once again proved how important E.N.F. is, especially in regards to receiving grants from Grand Lodge that can be used with the State. During the 2020-2021 year all 14 lodges reached the \$4.80 per member goal. New Hampshire contributed \$81,269.42 to E.N.F., and Grand Lodge gave New Hampshire \$251,400 in the form of special program grants, the State Charity Fund, bonus funding, Veterans Affairs Services, Scholarships, and Community Investment Programs. Never underestimate the importance of your donations to E.N.F. Let's continue doing great things in our communities by maintaining a consistent and generous spirit.

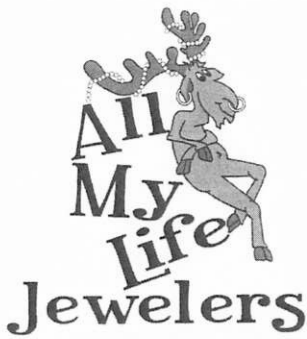

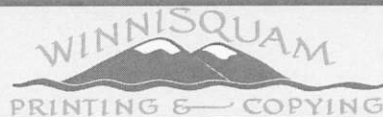

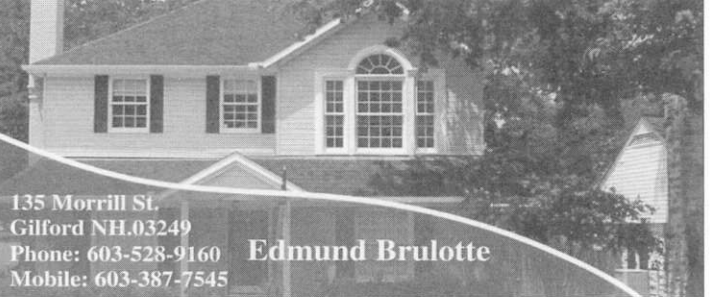
