## A Message from the Exalted Ruler May 2020



Currently there are more than the usual amount of residents in our local communities who are struggling to feed their families. 

Due to State regulations and the uncertainty of the overall health situation of the State of New Hampshire, the New Hampshire State Elks Association along with the management of Loon Mountain have cancelled the State Convention that would have been held mid-May. The State Association is currently in discussions to create the safest means possible for the mandatory State Meeting to be held. As developments unfold, our members will be informed. Additionally the District Deputy Clinic which was supposed to have been held on April 25th was canceled, and other arrangements are in the works.
