A Message from the Exalted Ruler

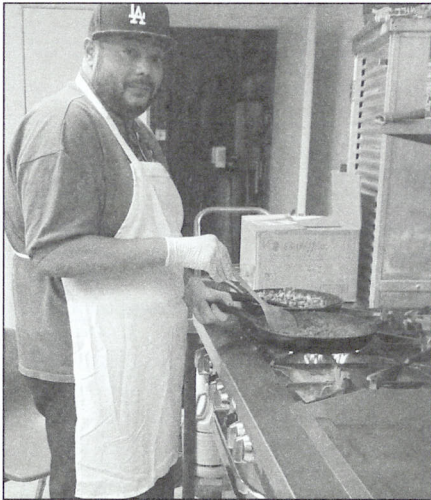
September 2018

Manager's Corner

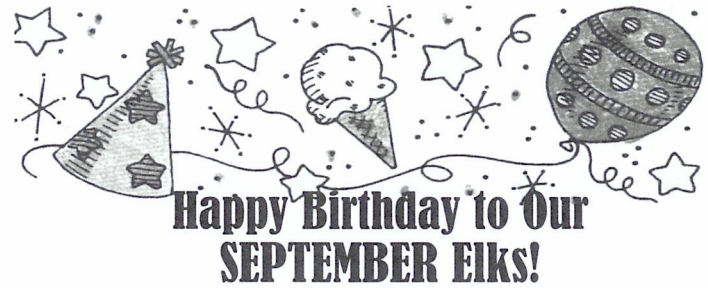
